

NEW VILLAGE OF ILION

SOLID WASTE, GREEN WASTE & NEW RECYCLING GUIDELINES

BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2013

Spohn's Disposal Service will continue trash, garbage and recycling pick-up in the Village of Ilion. Residents have the option to use either Village of Ilion garbage bags or totes/carts. The bag and toter/cart system applies to all Village residents and businesses that do not have private dumpster service or a private collection dumpster contract. **Residents who do not participate in the public solid waste system will not receive service for recycling or yard waste collection. New collection days and electronics recycling guidelines are below.**

VILLAGE GARBAGE BAGS

If you choose to continue to use the Village of Ilion garbage bags they are available at the following locations:

Rite Aid Pharmacy, Kinney Drugs, Nice-N-Easy, Fastrac, True Value Hardware and X-tra Mart
Cost for Village Bags: Large = \$3.60 and Small = \$2.95

TOTER/CART SYSTEM

If you choose to participate in the toter/cart system, please contact the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority Office via e-mail at: christine@ohswa.org or phone 733-1224 ext. 2000 to arrange for toter/cart service.

Cost for Toters/Carts [Payments to be made quarterly, in advance.]

32-gallon = \$61.50 per quarter

64-gallon = \$76.50 per quarter

95-gallon = \$94.50 per quarter

Examples of non-recyclable items: Plastic toys, light bulbs, window glass, dishes, flower pots, cook ware, wood, plaster/wallboard, oil containers, hardcover books, ceiling tile, pails and clothes hangers should be disposed as garbage in Village bag or toter/cart.

LARGE QUANTITIES OF TRASH [This includes all construction and demolition material]

Call a private hauler to rent a dumpster. Small pieces of wood, lumber, or construction debris can be placed in toter/cart or in Village trash bags (**DO NOT** mix it with brush or yard waste). Construction & demolition debris must be removed by the resident or by arrangement with a private hauler.

SCHEDULE/RULES FOR SETTING OUT GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES

- **NEW Garbage, Trash and Recyclables Collection: Wednesday, Thursday & Friday Routes**
- Garbage and recyclables should **NOT** be out before 3:00 PM but **SHOULD** be out before 12:00 midnight the night of our collection.
- Garbage Bags **SHOULD NOT EXCEED 50 pounds**.
- Empty totes/carts or cans must be removed from the curbside by 8:00 PM, the day of your scheduled collection.
- If your garbage or recyclables are not collected, contact Spohn's Disposal Service at 866-8820.
- **PLASTIC BAGS CANNOT BE RECYCLED. DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC BAGS IN RECYCLING CONTAINERS.**

BULK ITEMS COLLECTED WEEKLY [Wood, Lumber, Plaster, Wall Board, Electronics & Plywood are NOT BULK ITEMS]

- Bulk items are defined as large household items (i.e., couch, chair, mattress, table, rug (rolled & tied), cabinet, dresser etc.).
- **Electronics are no longer considered a bulk item. See below for recycling instructions.**
- **ONE bulk item per each property** may be put out on the same day as your garbage pick-up (i.e. dining table set of one table and four chairs equal five items, which will take five weeks to dispose).
- Bulk item must not be too large or heavy for two men to lift.

STEEL, METAL ITEMS, MAJOR APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS (i.e. TV, computer) & WHITE GOODS COLLECTED TWICE A MONTH

- **These items will be collected on the first and third Friday of each month. Electronics are now accepted for recycling on these days.**
- **These items must be called into Spohn's Disposal at 866-8820 to be put on a pick-up list for collection.** Please call before the collection day and state what type of material is to be picked up (i.e. washer, dryer, freezer, refrigerator, TV, water heater, etc.) so that special collection arrangements can be made.

GREEN/YARD WASTE COLLECTION [GREEN/YARD WASTE MUST BE TIED/BUNDLED OR CONTAINERIZED]

- **Set out Sunday night for Monday pick-up beginning April 1st through October 31st**
- *Green waste (grass clippings, leaves, garden waste and shrub clippings) must be placed in a reusable container only.*
- **DO NOT place Green Waste in Plastic Bags. No container should exceed 50 pounds.**
- *Green waste should be free of stones, wood, paper, plastic pots/trays and animal waste.*
- *Lumber and other construction debris IS NOT considered brush or yard waste.*
- *Brush and Shrubs cannot exceed four feet (4') and must be placed in a reusable container or tied and bundled.*
- **Christmas trees will be collected at the end of December and during the month of January.**

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The Village of Ilion DPW will continue to pick up seasonal leaves in the Fall. Leaves must be placed loose at the curb for collection. Scheduling and preparation for this service will be announced by the Village of Ilion DPW. (November 1st – As long as weather permits.)

SPECIAL ITEMS

Tires: Residents can deliver tires directly to the Solid Waste Authority's Residential Convenience Station on Leland Ave. in Utica, or contact a private hauler to have them removed.

Used Motor Oil: Take to a service station, oil redemption center or to the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority's Residential Convenience Station in Utica.
