

***Rabbit Hole* takes the stage at the Ilion Little Theatre**

Themes of loss, family, at center of Tony Award and Pulitzer Prize winning play

ILION, NY – The Ilion Little Theatre continues its 2016-2017 season with David Lindsay-Abaire’s Pulitzer Prize winning drama, *Rabbit Hole* beginning **Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m.** and running for six performances over the course of two weekends.

Becca (*Jennifer Rubino*) and Howie Corbett (*Andy Vogel*) have a picture-perfect family life in the suburbs of New York until a random, tragic accident takes the life of their four-year old son. Soon after, Becca’s younger, irresponsible sister, Izzy (*Danielle Piazza*), announces that she is pregnant: there will now be a new child in the family. As Becca and Howie grow apart, Becca’s mother, Nat (*Deborah Martin*), badgers Becca about her grieving process, and Jason, the young driver who killed their son, continually shows up to ask forgiveness, the group is on a bumpy road to healing with no road map in sight. *Rabbit Hole* delves into the complexity of a family navigating deep grief, and learning what it means to live a fruitful life when things fall apart. The play also features *Kaitlyn Tambasco* as Tracy.

Directed by Nicholas Priore, *Rabbit Hole* was the recipient of not only the 2007 Pulitzer Prize for Drama but also the 2006 Tony Award Winner for Best Performance by a Leading Actress in a Play. It was also nominated for several other Tony Awards.

Rabbit Hole continues the Little Theatre’s 2016-2017 Season and takes the stage December 2, 3, 9, and 10 at 8 p.m. along with two matinee performances December 4 and 11 at 2 p.m.
